Kyrgyzstan to legalize commercial surrogate maternity

The State Registration Service of Kyrgyzstan (SRS KR) intends to amend the law controlling surrogate maternity. SRS KR informs.

Reportedly, in Kyrgyzstan surrogate maternity is controlled by the Family Code, laws on Act of Civil Status, on Reproductive Rights and Guarantee of Realization. Commercial surrogate maternity is not prohibited. To exclude double interpretation of laws and protect rights and interests of surrogate mothers and biological parents as well as to exclude lawsuits between parties of the contract is necessary to bring into compliance some regulatory legal acts, according to SRS KR.

According to the department, no one regulatory legal act of the Kyrgyz Republic clearly specifies form and content of the contract on surrogate maternity.

Let's note that surrogate maternity is forbidden by the law in Austria, Germany, Norway, Sweden, France and in some states of the U.S. In some countries only noncommercial surrogate maternity is allowed.
